Instructions

- Complete application – check off all scholarships for which you are applying
 - o The application is located on our website.
- Obtain required documentation and recommendations
- Submit all required paperwork in one envelope or email by due date: March 31st
- Incomplete applications without all required information will not be considered
- If applying for more than one scholarship, one set of paperwork is sufficient

For the following scholarships

- Mid-Hudson Scholarship Fund General Scholarship
- Mid-Hudson Scholarship Fund Merit Scholarship - recognizing superior academic accomplishments
- Mid-Hudson Scholarship Fund Virtue Scholarship - no financial requirement and 2.5 GPA minimum
- Ruth Cleveland Endowed Scholarship
- Friends of Rhoda Scholarship - only available to SUNY New Paltz students - Preference given to non-traditional education student, i.e.: an individual who entered the teaching profession late, or one who had a gap between schooling

General Requirements (see specific scholarship for additional requirements)

- Completed application
- Full-time undergraduate or graduate student continuing education at a Mid-Hudson Valley college
- Cumulative GPA of at least 3.0
- Letter including:
 - o College academic achievement and honors
 - o Well-defined academic and professional goals
 - o Significant contributions made to your college and/or the community
- Two (2) recommendations, at least one (1) from your college teaching faculty
- Current (unofficial) college transcript
- Completed at least 12 credits at your college by application deadline
- Documentation of financial need — include one (1) of the following:
 - o Copy of tax return
 - o Financial aid application
 - o Statement of financial need included in letter

Mary Dixon Atkins Memorial Book Scholarship requirements

- Completed application
- Full time undergraduate student or graduate student or accepted freshman at SUNY New Paltz
- Must have a relative who graduated from SUNY New Paltz and who also lives in the Mid-Hudson area
- Letter including well-defined goals and sincerity of purpose
- Current (unofficial) transcript or schedule of classes from SUNY New Paltz
